DRIVING TEST DAY CHECKLIST

On the day of your test it's recommended you arrive 30 minutes early and you must:

- Bring your current driver licence. If you are using your current temporary licence you'll also need to bring photographic ID (18+ card, student ID card, or current passport)
- Bring your completed application form
- Bring payment
- Make sure your car has a current Warrant of Fitness
- Make sure your car has a current Registration
- Make sure your car has a current road user charges licence (only applicable if your driving a diesel car)
- Complete a pre-drive check of the car you'll be using for the test to make sure it's in good condition for your test (Tyres and wheels, indicators, lights, window wipers and general condition of the car)
- Wear your glasses or contact lenses if these are needed
- Plan to get to your testing station on time (if you arrive late your test will be cancelled)
- Check that your vehicle has enough fuel to complete the test



Creating Safer and More Confident Drivers

- Make sure the car has L-plates displayed at the front and rear of your car if you are on a learner licence
- Make sure that the car your test is being complete in is clean and tidy

Important: If you are on a learner licence you will need to make sure your accompanied to your test by a supervisor. Remember you are not legally allowed to drive solo until you pass your test.
